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1. Apologies

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr John Hatton, Cornwall Cllr Walter Sanger and the Police.

2. Members to declare pecuniary & prejudicial interests (incl details thereon) re any items on this agenda and any dispensations thereon previously granted or requested now

There were no declarations.

3. To receive PCSO Julia Berry's monthly report

During March there were two crimes reported to the police:

4. To receive Cornwall Cllr Walter Sanger's report

There was no Cornwall Council report.

5. Public questions (2 minutes each, 15 minutes total). This is your only chance to speak

The member of the public present was still chasing traffic calming for Rosevear and suggested 'average' speed cameras such as those recently installed at Trewennack. A member advised that they were being done as an experiment and

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Cornwall Council did not get any money from them – it was purely educational – to train drivers to adhere to speed limits. They cost £57k per pair. He also suggested the Clerk ask Cornwall Council whether Rosevear was included in the new Local Transport Plan being drawn up by Cornwall Council at present.

6. To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting

It was RESOLVED that the Chairman sign the minutes as a true and correct record of the previous meeting.

7. Matters arising from the minutes – not covered elsewhere in this agenda

This was not from the last meeting but there was an update on the new arms ordered for the Toy finger post on the A3083 at Skyburriowe Lane junction. The arms were complete and a member of the Milestone Society would be bringing them out to the Cormac depot at Helston in two days time. The Clerk had requested that Cormac erect them. It was noted.

8. To consider planning applications received from Cornwall Council

Cllr Mrs Dot Spragg had attended the planning meeting to support the application, after visiting the site and appraising herself of the situation. The application was passed and the applicants were very grateful for her support. It was noted.

10. To consider quotes for spraying weeds in village – suggested 3 x year = £150.00

It was RESOLVED to accept the quote for 3 sprays/year @ £50 each, total £150.00.

11. To consider quotes for pressure washing milestones and re-painting black lettering £95 x 3

Further to the advice given about the Toy finger post; Cornwall Council had agreed to the Milestone Society carrying on refurbishing milestones for a further two years, and it would now be repainting all the milestones on the B3293 to St Keverne, having done the ones on the A3083 last year. The Parish Council would then be expected to maintain them. A start would be made in two days time, when the Toy arms were delivered to Helston. It was noted.

12. To approve £200 expenditure for CPR training sessions

It was RESOLVED to approve the expenditure of £200 on CPR training for parishioners. It would need to be advertised and names collected.

13. Feast Week

As only 3 people had attended the Feast meeting arranged for 30th March, some arrangements were discussed and put in hand.
